

Understanding Employment Act 1955: New Amendments Updates In 2022

On October 25, 2021, the proposed amendments to Malaysia's Employment Act 1955 were tabled for its first reading in parliament. The amendments include extending pregnancy and maternity protection, allowing employees to apply for flexible working arrangements, and the creation of a new offence of 'forced labor, among others. The changes aim to bring the Act to 'international standards' as required by the Trans-Pacific Partnership (TPP), the International Labor Organization (ILO), and the Malaysia-United States Labor Consistency Plan.
