OVERVIEW

Obtaining the employment pass & work permits in Malaysia can be complex and time-consuming, with strict requirements and restrictions in place. As an expatriate & foreign employee, you may only work for the company named in your employment pass, and if you change employers, you will need to re-submit a new application. Additionally, there are strict limitations on the number of foreign expatriates a Malaysian company can employ. To apply for an employment pass, your company must demonstrate to the government that the position and the expatriate are vital and cannot be filled by local citizens.
